Parents

- 1. No parents in the dugout.
- 2. Parents will not coach from the stands.
- 3. Parents will not argue with Umpires, Opposing Coaches, or Opposing Parents.
- 4. Parents will focus their players on competition and not just winning & losing.
- 5. Parents will allow their athlete to perform and progress at a level consistent with his/her ability and experience.
- 6. Parents will support athletes after challenging games.
- 7. Parents will support the coaching staff when controversial decisions are made. The coaches need your backing to keep good morale on the team. Any issues or disagreements you may have will be discussed in private.
- 8. Alcohol use is not permitted at games or practices.
- 9. Tacoma Select is a gun-free zone. Guns are not allowed in the facility or or any school grounds.
- 10. Be on time! If your athlete will be late for practice or a game, you will personally communicate with one of the coaches, informing them. GroupMe, text, or phone call will be the preferred communication method.
- 11. Absences for games need to be communicated ASAP in order to ensure a full roster.

Players

- 1. In the dugout, players will focus on baseball.
- 2. Players will not use cell phones during practices or games ~ unless it is an emergency.
- 3. During games, players will limit contact with anyone off the field or outside the dugout.
- 4. Players will always hustle. We will out-hustle and out-work our opponents.
- 5. Proper attire must be worn at games and practice. Slides are NOT allowed on the field or indoor turf.
- 6. Players will arrive at games and practice prepared.
- 7. Helmet throwing, abusing equipment, using profanity, and/or temper tantrums will not be tolerated. Any player caught doing so will be benched.
- 8. You will not show up/confront umpires, opposing players, opposing coaches, teammates, coaches, or spectators. You will address the coaching staff properly at all times. Private conversations about disagreements will be held off the field in private.
- 9. Players will not transfer blame or make excuses.
- 10. Players will not taunt or disparage teammates for making errors or not making plays. Instead, you will pick up your teammates and encourage them.
- 11. Players will respect other players' property and ask permission before using equipment that is not your own.
- 12. If you are sore/hurt/injured, you must tell a coach.
- 13. Players must report school pitch counts to their coach or trainer.
- 14. Bullying will not be tolerated. Bullying will lead to removal from the program.
- 15. No pickup playing without prior approval from your coach.
- 16. HS players must maintain a passing grade to play and practice.
